

Borax Crystal Fractal

Supplies

- 1. Borax
- 2. Pipe Cleaner
- 3. Craft Stick
- 4. See Through Glass
- 5. Yarn
- 6. Microwave or Stove Top With Pot
- 7. Water

Directions:

- 1. Fill the glass with water and either microwave it or pour the water into the pot and heat the water until it boils.
- While water is heating, cut a pipe cleaner in half two times. Twist the pieces together in the middle until it resembles a snowflake.
- Tie a piece of yarn to the snowflake and then to the craft stick. Tie it so that snowflake will not touch the class when hanging in the water.
- 4. When the water starts to boil, pour ½ cup of borax into the boiling water and stir until it dissolves.
- 5. Carefully pour the water into the glass and hang the snowflake in the cup. Make sure the snowflake only touches the water and not the glass.
- 6. Let the glass sit on a counter for 12-24 hours.
- 7. After the 12-24 hours, lift the stick and notice the fractal crystals that have formed on the snowflake!
