

## Supplies

1. Borax
2. Pipe Cleaner
3. Craft Stick
4. See Through Glass
5. Yarn
6. Microwave or Stove Top With Pot
7. Water



## Directions:

1. Fill the glass with water and either microwave it or pour the water into the pot and heat the water until it boils.
2. While water is heating, cut a pipe cleaner in half two times. Twist the pieces together in the middle until it resembles a snowflake.
3. Tie a piece of yarn to the snowflake and then to the craft stick. Tie it so that snowflake will not touch the glass when hanging in the water.
4. When the water starts to boil, pour  $\frac{1}{2}$  cup of borax into the boiling water and stir until it dissolves.
5. Carefully pour the water into the glass and hang the snowflake in the cup. Make sure the snowflake only touches the water and not the glass.
6. Let the glass sit on a counter for 12-24 hours.
7. After the 12-24 hours, lift the stick and notice the fractal crystals that have formed on the snowflake!
